Dr. Frédérique Sachwald is Head of the company R&D unit and advisor to the Strategy Direction at the French Ministry of research. She was formerly Head of economic studies at IFRI in Paris and has taught in various institutions. She studied at the *Institut d'Etudes Politiques* and *Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales* in Paris, and at Cambridge University (UK).

She has worked in the fields of industrial and international economics and has explored several aspects of globalization and its impact on domestic economies. She has also studied the development of global production and innovation networks by multinationals and their impact on trade, knowledge flows and local economies.

Dr. Frédérique Sachwald writes in various journals.
